

8 Ways for You To



1. Pray that more & more people would be moved to share their material blessings with those in need and that God would “establish the work of our hands” as we strive to give hope to those in need.

2. Join the \$5 (a month) club and donate just \$60 to Help A Child each year. You won't miss it and if just 100 people sign up we can support 15 children.



This can be done online with your bank, at our website (via credit card) or simply by sending a check (every month, quarter or year; it's up to you).

3. If you use facebook become a fan by visiting www.facebook.com/helpachild.us and clicking on “like”. We've been posting film clips, photos, news updates, and will soon be posting children in need of sponsorship. You can be a great help if you share our postings with your group of friends. This is an easy way for you to help us spread the word.

4. Sponsor job training for a young man or woman in Zambia with a gift of \$380 ([see next page](#)). This provides an invaluable helping hand to a young person who otherwise has little or no hope of providing

5. Join the \$5 (a week) club and donate \$260 to the general fund of Help A Child each year. If we get 50 people willing to make this commitment we can help 30 more children escape the bonds of poverty and hopelessness. As with the \$5 a month club (above) you can easily arrange with your bank to send a regular check (weekly, monthly or annually), you can sign up via credit card on our website or you can send a check. We hope that many of you will sign up for the \$5 club to help provide us with a stable base of support thereby enabling us to help more children and families in need.

The Munyaneza family of Rwanda: when this photo was taken the father was hard at work and the youngest daughter was at school. This family is very poor and they don't have any land to cultivate. They are in need of help. Your sponsorship would mean the 2 older children could attend school. The mother would receive training to raise small livestock for sale. The family would be able to receive medical care. Please consider helping this family, or another family like them, so that they can learn to help themselves.

7. Sponsor a family in Rwanda for \$55 per month. Help A Child partners with the AEE (Africa Evangelistic Enterprise) in Rwanda. We need sponsors to help us provide support to an entire family for a few years until they are able to fend for themselves. This usually involves job training for one of the parents, making sure that the children can attend school, medical care and other material provisions as needed. The idea is to provide help for a short time to enable the family to become self-sufficient.

8. Make a one-time donation of anywhere from \$10 to \$10,000 to support the work of Help A Child in Zambia. This money would be put to good use to help with the various projects you can read about on the [next page](#) such as, training farmers to improve methods of production, improving access roads to villages & farmland to facilitate transport of goods to the market, teacher training and job training for youth.
