Kenyan Children In Need of Sponsors

Have you ever noticed how easily you can spend \$5 here or there without giving it much thought?

In recent years Help A Child has been relying more and more on larger gifts from a smaller number of sponsors. Although we greatly value these generous gifts, we find we are becoming increasingly vulnerable if such a sponsor suddenly stops giving. With the \$5 club we hope to expand our donor base by increasing the number of sponsors giving smaller donations. If you feel this is a worthy cause and you can afford \$5 per month (\$60 per year), or \$5 per week (\$260 per year) please **let us know by filling out the enclosed response card and mailing it back to us.** Rather than sponsoring a specific child, these gifts would be used where most needed. Of course any other amount is also welcome. Checks or automatic bank payments (see below) can be sent in any desired frequency (e.g. per week, month or year).

Automatic Payments

We would like to encourage sponsors who do not already do so to consider setting up your monthly, quarterly or annual donations to Help A Child as an automatic or recurring check payment with your bank; especially those of you who are already initiated into the art of online banking and have started paying your bills in this way. This would result in a more regular and dependable flow of income for Help A Child. Most banks offer this service free of charge and it can usually be set-up in a few minutes. For those sponsors who prefer to send a regular check through the mail instead, please continue to do so.
