Help A Child Providing Emergency Aid To Children & Their Families In Pakistan

Recent figures show that as many as 20 million people have been affected by the floods in Pakistan and India. Many of them are now dependent on aid for their daily needs and survival. Expectations are that the magnitude of the disaster will continue to increase as the floodwaters make their way downstream and the monsoon rains continue to fall. Care workers and team leaders of our partner organizations have already visited the area to assess the most critical needs. Those affected have lost land, live stock and their often already meager possessions. Those living on the poverty line have been hit the hardest. They have no other means of existence.

Help A Child, in cooperation with four other Dutch Christian aid organizations, has started an emergency relief effort to help alleviate the suffering caused by the floods. We will be providing aid in the form of food, tents and tarps, mosquito nets, kitchen utensils and gas stoves for preparing meals. Apart from these essential items we will distribute articles for personal hygiene, such as soap, hand towels, toothbrushes and toothpaste.
